1. A current Negative Coggins is required at the Secretaries Stand to receive a number.
2. Ridge Road Stable committee and the volunteers will not be responsible for any loss or injury to any person, horse, or property incurred on any of the show grounds.
3. Riders must wear a SEI approved helmet while mounted on a horse anywhere on the grounds.
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to make any adjustments necessary to make the show run in a timely manner.
5. All dogs must be leashed.
6. The show will run in accordance with current USEF Rules and PA Equestrian Association Rules.
7. All Equine activities are pursuant to PA Equine Law Act 93 of 2005
8. No exhibitors, trainers nor spectators will be permitted to speak directly to a judge without making arrangements with show management.
9. NO OUTSIDE BEDDING OF ANY KIND
10. Any stalls have any type of equipment in them must be paid for, this includes but is not limited to muck buckets, pitch forks, clothing, hay, shavings, etc.

Open Card Handy Round

Handy round that will run as an open card all day at heights of 2', 2'3", 2'6", and 3'. Will pay back all entry fees collected

Child/Adult Hunter

Open to any horse ridden by an amateur adult or child. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into Low Adult/Child hunter. Fences at 3'

Professional Division

Open to any adult professional. To be judged on the horse. Fences at 2'6" or 3'.

Low Adult/Child Hunter Horse

Open to any horse ridden by an amateur or child. To be judged on horse. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into Adult/Children's Hunter. Fences at 2'6"

Adult/Jr Equitation

Open to adults and children. To be judged on overall ability and turnout. Course can include roll backs, bending lines, trot jumps, and/or jumper style jumps. Fences at 2'6" for horses and 2' for ponies (children only)

Children's Hunter Pony

Open to any child. To be judged on the pony. May not cross enter into Low Children's Pony. Fences at 2' for smalls, 2'3" for mediums and 2'6" for larges.

Open Pleasure

To be judged on overall pleasurableness of horse and rider. Fences at 2' for ponies and 2'3" for horses

Baby Green Hunter

Open to horse or pony in their first or second year of showing. To be judged on the horse or pony. Only children to ride ponies. Fences at 2' for ponies and 2'3" for horses.

Suitable Hunter

To be judged on horse or pony, open to all. Fences at 2'3"

TB Hunter

To be judged on horse, open to all thoroughbreds. Fences at 2'3".

Modified Hunter

Open to any horse or pony ridden by amateur adult or child. To be judged on horse. Fences at 2'.

2' Child/Adult Equitation

Open to any children or amateur. To be judged on position and overall ability. Fences at 2'.

Low Children's Pony

Open to any child. To be judged on pony. May not cross enter into Children's pony. Fences at 2'.

Leadline

Open to riders 7 years old and under

Mini Stirrup

Open to riders 8 years old and under

Open W/T and W/T/C

Open to all. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any jumping classes

Pre-Short Stirrup

Open to riders 8 years old and under. May not cross enter into any other classes where jumping is permitted

Beginner Rider

Open to children who are in their first or second year of showing. To be judged on position and overall ability.

Open X-Rails

Open to all. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into any jumping classes where fences exceed 2'.

Short Stirrup Equitation Open to riders 10 years old and under. To be judged on position and overall ability

Short Stirrup Hunter

Open to riders 10 years old and under. To be judged on horse/pony. Riders may not cross enter into other divisions where fences exceed 2'

Long Stirrup

Open to riders 11 years old and older.

Colonial points are only for 18 years and over
